KIGEME DIOCESE

The focus for this newsletter is the Diocese of Kigeme down in the southwest of Rwanda. This is a poor area, but one that has seen sustained church growth both under the previous Bishop Augustine Mvunabandi and now under Bishop Assiel Musabyimana. Then last year the diocese split into two and Nyaruguru diocese was created. Each diocese is now co-terminus with a civic District.

Bishop Assiel has given a high priority to training both the pastors and catechists, and Rwanda Direct has helped support that training over the years. This well trained, vibrant leadership has then led to the growth of the church. Here are some recent pictures that give a feel of what God is doing. Bishop Assiel writes:-

PASTOR QUALIFICATIONS

As you already know, the Rwandan Government issued a demand in 2018 that every pastor in all denominations must have a degree qualification in five years' time. This is now being implemented. Much has been done to train new pastors and there are many more with degrees. Rwanda Direct has funded some of these over the last 5 years. However, there are still those who either haven't had the opportunity to get a degree or who don't speak English adequately to study at that level. The dioceses will be looking to support these folk as the degree trained pastors take the lead, and they are reposted to effectively lower-level posts. This isn't easy, and much grace and wisdom will be needed.

VISIT 2024

5 of us are heading to Rwanda at the end of January through to mid-February. We have a full programme planned, visiting our partners and picking up on all our relationships and projects. We should be able to report more fully upon our return. As ever, we will be based at Scripture Union in Kigali, and will tour out to Kigeme, Byumba and Gahini as well as visiting Kigali Diocese and EACC.
